**Once you have completed this week you may advance to as many other camps as you would like.*



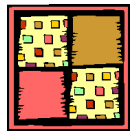
Clothing Camp - during this week of camp you will make as many clothing items as time allows. You can make anything from shorts, a

Already have an American Girl doll? Why not make her a new outfit or two!



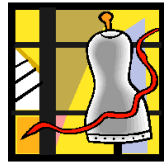
Quilt Camp - during this week of camp you will choose fabric squares of your favorite colors and sew them together. Then you

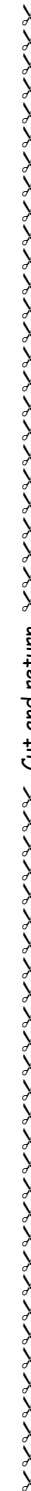

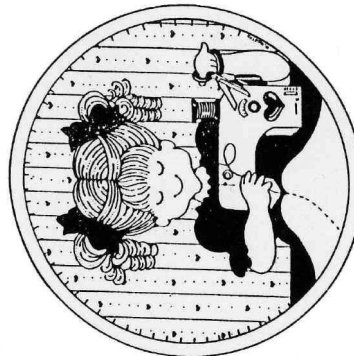

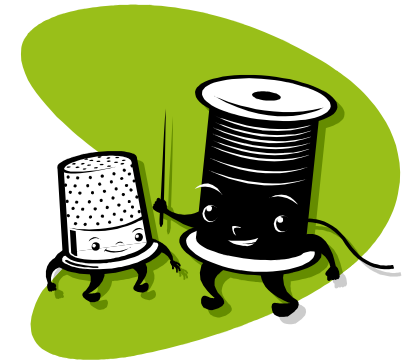
