<u>*Learn To Sew Camp</u> – during this week of camp you will learn the parts of the machine, how to pin and cut, and how to straight stitch and zigzag. Your first project is a sewing bag which you will keep your sewing projects in. You can also make a pair of shorts, a top, or pick a craft to make.

> *Once you have completed this week you may advance to as many other camps as you would like.


